



NEWSLETTER - Aalborg, Denmark

Sunday, May 29th, the foreign students and teachers from Portugal and the Netherlands arrived in Aalborg during the day.



We Food sells goods that regular supermarkets no longer can sell due to exceeded “best before” dates, incorrect labels or damaged packaging. First we got a short introduction about the whole idea and afterward we saw the shop and bought some candy. In the evening we (the group from Portugal and the Danish group) met at Noah's house.



Tuesday, May 31th, the morning started at a “Genbrugsplads” - a garbage sorting for the inhabitants of Aalborg. We got a lot of information about this place and we went on a little tour among all the containers. After the tour we had to walk or take a bus to the center of Aalborg. My group just walked:) In Aalborg’s old town we entered in several groups on a guided tour. We ended up in a Historical Museum. It was quite a big museum, where we were allowed to walk around by ourselves.

Then we had some spare time (we went to MacDonal’d’s) before we had to be at the school again at 14.00. Now it was time for workshops! There were four workshops of one hour duration: Linedance, QR code - food waste race, Providing decorations for the party Friday evening at the ballroom and cooking food based on groceries with exceeded dates.
