


Newsletter from the Czech Republic

The first LTT activity of our Erasmus+ project “Happy, Healthy, Wise and Wealthy” KA229 took place in Uherské Hradiště between the 2nd to 8th April 2022.

Day 1 - Saturday 2nd april

We woke up early in the morning and then began a long journey. First, we drove two hours to Billund Airport where we had a scheduled flight at 10:20 AM. We ate breakfast at the airport and prepared for our flight but then the flight data updated and it displayed “Delayed”. We thought at first it was a short delay of maybe 15-30 minutes, but when we passed 10:20 and the plane had not arrived yet we asked the staff and they told us the plane had not left Warszawa yet.... We decided to have a nice time in the airport with each other. We drove around in the shopping carts, went shopping and almost missed our flights toward Warsaw. Then we arrived at the airport in Warsaw where we missed our flight due to the huge delay in Billund. At the airport in Warsaw, we had to go to the information desk to get further information and the line was already incredibly long, but somehow Inge managed to sneak in the front and saved us at least 2 hours in line. As a complimentary we each got a voucher for hotel, catering, taxi and 110 DKK to spend in Denmark. We got our language and started our journey to get some food and we went through security again. Oliver got stopped in the metal detector and the angry security man shouted “jump, jump, jump” and Oliver started jumping, which just made the security man even more angry. We got in the airport again but decided to leave again - without food... We went back and forth to the airport in search of food, we spoke with security guards, stewards and office workers but none of them could help us, so we decided we should get a meal at McDonald’s. We ate and left the airport in four taxis and then spent the rest of the night at the hotel with fitness and dinner.



Day 2 - Sunday 3th April

We woke up at the hotel and went for breakfast. The breakfast was pretty decent - Scrambled eggs, toast and some crappy baked beans. We decided to take a taxi to the city center in Warsaw where we spent six hours in Warsaw with shopping, sightseeing and food - Waffles, Soup, Cake and even Salmon with mashed potatoes. We then went back to the hotel, where we spent a couple of hours before we took off to the airport again. We then got to the airport. The check-in process was a mess. The man behind the desk got angry and our baggage ended up in a strange limbo in the airport system already and a new request, but we got it fixed and went through security. We then went to the restaurant to get some food. Then we still had some vouchers left which were the compensation so we

went to the McDonalds just before the plane departure and then we brought the book aboard on the aircraft. We then had a flight with only 16 people aboard - 8 from Denmark and some drunk polish guys. We then landed at 0:30 Monday - Then we had 2 hours back in a taxi and we arrived at the



Unesco school at 2:30 AM.

Day 3 - Monday 4th April

We woke up early in the morning. We got about 2-3 hours of sleep because our flight got delayed. We got ready for school. At the school the students went to practice their welcome ceremony. In the meantime, we got a guided tour around the school. After the tour we met up with our teachers and then we went to the welcome ceremony. We saw the videos all the countries had made of their school. After each video the country's students had to present themselves. In the "part time show" the younger students danced to a song named baby shark. After that the students danced for us, which was beautiful. Then after that some of the younger students did some gymnastics for us. They were really good, really talented! After the welcome ceremony we did some presentations about recycling and we did some workshops. We got to meet the students from the other countries. After school the girls went to a little town where they tried lots of different things and foods. The boys went to the cinema to watch "the Batman". Then we had some drama in the evening - we thought one of the Danish girls got to the hospital, but it turned out to be a false alarm fortunately.

Day 4 - Tuesday 5th April

We woke up in the morning and got ready for "school". In the school we started to meet with all the other kids, and teachers in the Erasmus project. After that we walked about four kilometers, to a water cleaning place, which cleaned the water of two big towns and one small village, but as expected it was very smelly, and the water looked disgusting. A little later we walked even longer, probably like six kilometers, or it definitely felt like that. Afterwards we walked up a little hill, and we got split up into some groups. In the groups we got a guide who showed us around some old buildings from the seventeenth century. Unfortunately, I got a guide who was really bad at English so it was really hard to understand what he was saying, but it was really funny to hear him trying to talk English, because he was so bad at it. When we were done there, we walked to the school canteen, where we ate some food. When we were done eating and got outside, none of us knew what to do, so we were just standing in front of the canteen, and didn't know what to do. Eventually we found out that we wanted to try a Berliner bun, which didn't taste as good as in Denmark. Then the boys walked to a supermarket called "Kaufland", where we bought some energy drinks and some super cool sunglasses. The last thing we did was to go home to our hostess.

Day 5 - Wednesday 6th April

Today we started the day off with a meeting at the school at 08:30 AM, then we walked to the recycling site. At the recycling site we drove by a train around the entire site. We saw how the different materials were sorted and how they were recycled. After that we went for a walk around the zoo and saw the different animals made of scrap metal, we also saw old cars, ambulances and fire trucks. After our little trip it was time to get into the blacksmith where we made some nails. After that we had some spare time which we spent exploring the rest of the park. After a few hours it was time for lunch which we ate in their canteen. Now we were done with the recycling site and the park. Then we met at the bus station and took a bus to a bigger city called “Live” where the famous shoe brand called Bata is made, then we took another bus to a shopping center where we spent the rest of the day shopping and eating.



Day 6 - Thursday 7th April

Today was a group tour with the bus. We went to a village called Hostětín. We visited an eco-village where they worked with projects about saving the environment. First we got some information before we were divided into groups where we had to do some small tasks about the environment. Afterwards we went to see the village and the surroundings. What a walk! A very long one and full of mud. But we had a great time anyway. Then the bus drove us to a restaurant also in a little village. Late in the afternoon we arrived to the school. And then it was time to say goodbye to all the students from the other countries. Some of them we are happy to see again in Denmark in May. We spent the evening with our host families and packed our bags for the next day's take off.



Day 7 - Friday 8th April

In the morning our host families drove us to the school where two taxis waited for us to take us to Ostrava. The drive took one and a half hour. In that small airport there was absolutely nothing to do, so we were just hanging around and taking some silly pictures. Then we flew to Warsaw in Poland. We were very lucky this day - no delays. We waited 2 hours and shopped a little and ate at Burger King before we flew to Billund in Denmark. In Billund some of our parents waited and the last 2 hours in the car to Aalborg we all slept. It has been a long travel day.
